

PETITION: Access to Dental Care for Seniors

These are the reasons for this petition:

- The 2016 Liberal budget eliminated the Adult Dental Program for low-income seniors;
- Oral health has been scientifically proven to have a major impact on overall health, medical costs, and quality of life;
- The Adult Dental Program for youth and seniors only cost government \$2.5 million in 2015; and
- Reversing these cuts would save our overstretched public health care system money and resources in the long-term;

Therefore, we, the undersigned, call upon the House of Assembly to urge the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador to ensure easy, affordable access to dental care for low-income seniors until the federal dental program expands this fall.
