## **NDP Motion Receives Unanimous Support to Improve Interprovincial Travel for Labradorians**

NL NDP MHA Jordan Brown (Labrador West) is pleased that his Private Members Motion urging the government to improve air access to, from and within Labrador was unanimously supported by all members of the House of Assembly.

Brown says that it was great to hear members stand and speak in debate and recognize the importance of Labrador – its residents, geographical features, culture and beauty and the mineral resources, fishing and electrical power that benefit all of the province.

“I want to thank my colleagues for showing their support for this motion. It was a great dedicated to talking about Labrador, and the contribution it makes to the province,” said Brown.

“Labrador is often forgotten when it comes to addressing many issues like cost of housing, healthcare, groceries and especially affordable interprovincial travel.
