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Dinn Attending Federal NDP Convention in Manitoba

ST. JOHN'S, NL – NL NDP Leader Jim Dinn is travelling to Winnipeg to attend the Federal New Democratic Party Convention for the election of a new federal leader and connect with New Democrats from across the country.
