Dear Mr. Wakeham,

In anticipation of the release of the Independent Review Committee Report on the Churchill Falls MOU, I ask that you make time available in the House of Assembly for Members to pose questions to the three members of the Committee on their research and findings.

We propose adopting the same process and rules used by the previous government for its extraordinary sitting of the House in January 2025. As you recall, senior staff from NL Hydro and other key people involved in negotiations came before the House to answer questions from all members. MHAs and party leaders also received double the amount of speaking time. Given that there are only three witnesses to call, we ask that debate be allowed for a minimum of two days.

Given the trust you have expressed in the Committee members and their work, I am certain that you will have no hesitations about inviting them to share their findings with us, and by extension, the public. In the interest of fairness and transparency, I look forward to your acceptance of this proposal.
